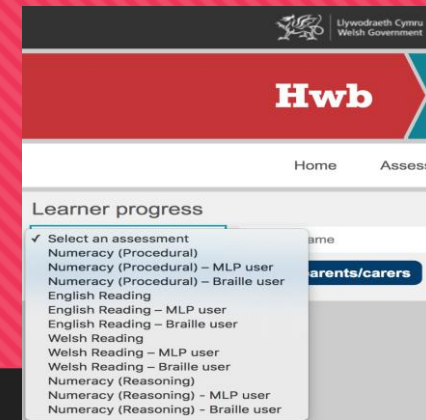

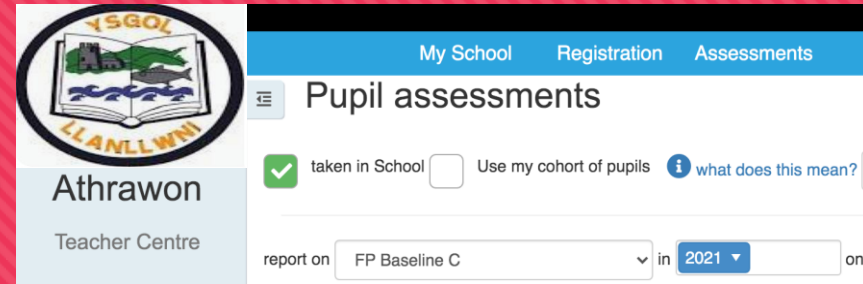

Profion Llythrennedd a Rhifedd - Literacy and Numeracy Tests

- Ym mis Mai eleni, cafodd disgyblion o flwyddyn 2 i 6 gyfle i sefyll profion safonedig darllen a rhifedd (rhif a rhesymu) Llywodraeth Cymru. Rhaeadrwyd y canlyniadau i'r rhieni ar ddiwedd tymor yr haf. Mae yr athrawon yn ymateb i ganlyniadau'r disgyblion yn ystod tymor yr Hydref 2024 gan dargedu meysydd i'w datblygu.
- *In May 2025, pupils from years 2 to 6 had the opportunity to sit the Welsh Government's standardized reading and numeracy (number and reasoning) tests. The results were cascaded to parents at the end of the summer term. Teachers are responding to pupil results by targeting areas for improvement during the autumn term 2025.*
- *This year, the school based its analysis of data on progress and attainment from Summer 2025. Staff continue to analyse data in many ways. Targets for the school are the result of such analysis which feed into the school development plan.*

Assessment Arrangements



- Rydym yn defnyddio cyfuniad o systemau tracio cadarn sy'n ein galluogi i gynhyrchu proffiliau disgyblion unigol sy'n cwmpasu ystod o sgoriau aseu a data ar bob disgybl. Mae'r proffiliau hyn yn cynnwys gwybodaeth am bresenoldeb, Lles, a chynnydd academaidd. Rydym yn dadansoddi cynnydd disgyblion unigol yn ogystal â chynnydd carfan ac yn eu defnyddio i osod targedau ar gyfer gwella yn y dyfodol.
- O dan y cwricwlwm newydd, ffocws canolog y trefniadau aseu yw sicrhau bod dysgwyr yn deall sut maent yn perfformio a beth sydd angen iddynt ei wneud nesaf er mwyn symud ymlaen. Mae pwyslais o'r newydd ar aseu ar gyfer dysgu fel nodwedd hanfodol ac annatod o ddysgu ac addysgu. **O ganlyniad, newidwyd fformat adroddiadau i rieni i fodloni y disgwyliadau statudol newydd o 2022.**
- Fel ysgol rydym hefyd yn monitro lles pob disgybl i sicrhau eu bod yn cael y gefnogaeth sydd ei hangen arnynt i gael y cyfleoedd bywyd gorau.

- We use a combination of robust tracking systems that enables us to produce individual pupil profiles covering a range of assessment scores and data on each pupil. These profiles contain information regarding attendance and academic progress. We analyse individual pupil progress as well as cohort progress (which we use to review teaching and learning) and set future targets for improvement.
- Under the new curriculum, the central focus of assessment arrangements is to ensure learners understand how they are performing and what they need to do next in order to progress. There is a renewed emphasis on assessment for learning as an essential and integral feature of learning and teaching. **As a result, reporting to parents has been amended to meet new statutory expectations from 2022.**
- As a school we also monitor the well-being of every pupil to ensure they are getting the support they need to have the best life opportunities.

- Survival and development;
- Participation of the child in decisions that affects their life.

Our aim as a school is to inspire learners to be the best they can be and reach their full potential!

This is based on Article 29 of the UNCRC, the right of all children to develop their talents and skills to the full.



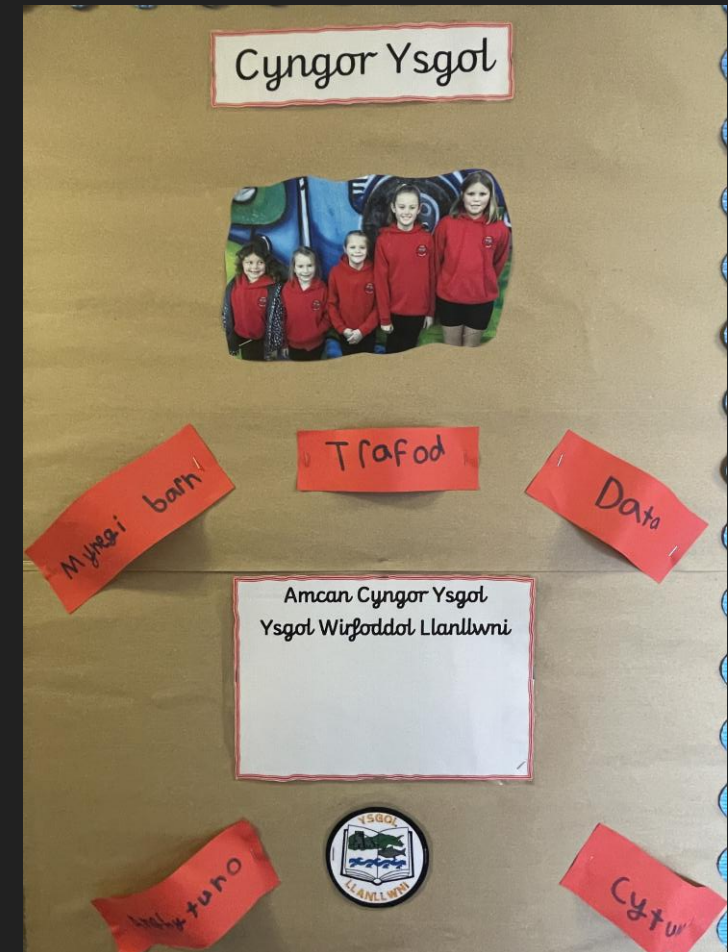

Criw Cymraeg

- Mae Criw Cymraeg Llanllwni yn anelu i godi statws ac i hyrwyddo'r defnydd o'r Gymraeg fel iaith ffurfiol ac iaith hamdden yn yr Ysgol.
- Mae'r aelodau yn trefnu amrywiol weithgareddau dathlu Cymreictod fel Diwrnod Owain Glyndwr, Dydd Miwsig Cymru, a Diwrnod Siwmai Su'mae.
- Mae'r pwyllgor wedi bod yn llunio cynlluniau ac Ymchwilio i ffyrdd o annog a chynyddu defnydd anffurfiol pob dydd o'r Gymraeg yn yr ysgol gan bob disgybl. Cyflwynir gwobrau Cymro a Chymraes yr wythnos yn y gwasanaeth ysgol.
- Criw Cymraeg Llanllwni aims to raise the status and promote the use of Welsh as a formal and leisure language at the School.
- Members organize various activities to celebrate Welshness such as Owain Glyndwr's Day, Welsh Music Day, and Siwmai Su'mae Day.
- The committee have been drawing up plans on Investigate ways of encouraging and increasing everyday informal use of Welsh at school by all pupils. Weekly Awards are presented in the school assembly to celebrate the pupils' efforts in developing their use of the Welsh language in everyday activities.

Darpariaeth Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol

Additional Learning Needs Provision

- Mae gan Miss Ch Evans (ALNCO) gyfrifoldeb ar gyfer monitro'r curriculum a chyd-lynu'r ddarpariaeth ar gofer disgyblion sydd ag anghenion addysgol arbennig. Mae'r drefn hon yn ymateb yn briodol i ofynion curriculum y plant.
- Miss Ch Evans (ALNCO) has responsibility for monitoring the curriculum and co-ordinating provision for pupils with additional learning needs. This system responds appropriately to the requirements of the children's curriculum.
- During the year we have fully implemented the new law for Additional Learning Needs and provide an equally high standard of support, in line with the Additional Learning Needs Code for Wales 2021.
- All mandated groups of pupils have been transferred over from the previous SEN system to the new ALN system and issued with IDPs where deemed necessary.

Ein Cofrestr Anghenion Arbennig

How is the ALN Register Constructed?

- Cedwir Cofrestr o ddisgyblion sydd efo Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol a chaiff ei adolygu'n rheolaidd. Mae hyn yn galluogi'r ysgol i fonitro anghenion y disgyblion hynny sydd angen cymorth ychwanegol, gan fodloni gofynion y Cod Ymarfer need ar gofer Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol.
- An Additional Learning Needs Register is maintained and is regularly reviewed. This enables the school to monitor the needs of those pupils who require additional support, and is consistent with the requirements of the Additional Learning Needs Code of Practice.
- When a member of the teaching staff has concerns related to the academic progress, emotional development or medical condition of a pupil, they bring their concerns to the attention of the Additional Learning Needs Co-ordinator (ALNCO).
- The teacher and ALNCO then decide on a course of action and decide whether a pupil requires a Notice of ALN or not. Pupils with a Statement of Educational Needs have now being transferred over to the new ALN System and issued with IDPs in place of the statement.
- Any Looked after Child (LAC), or pupil who is monitored by Social Services, is automatically placed on the ALN Register.
- The school also receives additional funds to help support individual focus groups of pupils through the Pupil Deprivation Grant (PDG) and Educational Improvement Grant (EIG).

What is an individual Development Plan and Who is issued one?

All pupils identified as having Additional Learning Needs are required by the Code of Practice to receive an individual programme of work, which is constructed with direct reference to their individual needs. In accordance with the requirements of the Code of Practice, the view of parents and pupils are sought and recorded within the review process.

Who is Responsible for Delivering ALN Support Within Our School?

Miss Charlotte Evans is the ALNCO (Additional Needs Co-Coordinator). Support is also provided by Teaching Assistants, under the guidance of class teachers when appropriate. Miss Evans is always happy to discuss your child's progress in relation to additional learning needs, should you wish to do so.

New ALN Bill

There is now a new statutory ALN Bill in place and being implemented by the school. The new Additional Learning Needs Code for Wales 2021 guides schools on how we may support children under the new law.

Who is the Governor with Responsibility for Special Needs?

The Code of Practice requires that a member of the governing body is allocated the responsibility of liaising with the ALNCO and Head Teacher, in order to maintain a high standard of provision for children with additional learning needs. In the case of Llanllwni Primary School the named **Governor with Responsibility for Special Needs** is Mrs Iona Lloyd-Davies.

- The school has a broad and balanced curriculum in Sport and Exercise, which deals firmly with skills development. The school offers two hours of physical education each week as part of our curriculum.
- We also take part individually and in teams in competitive sporting activities against other local schools in events such as netball, cross-country, football, rugby, swimming, dance, cricket and athletics. School teams are very successful, with individuals and teams representing the region and the County.

Ysgol Llanllwni is a Welsh medium community primary school. Welsh is the language of all lessons in the Foundation Phase. English is introduced formally at the beginning of Year 3. Our aim is for all pupils to be fully bilingual as they transfer to secondary education.

Welsh is also the language of activities outside the classroom e.g. assemblies, after school clubs, guest speakers etc.

We always strive to promote Welshness in school through Criw Cymraeg, Urdd activities and participating in Eisteddfodau and Sports.

- They will also get a deep understanding of how to thrive in an increasingly digital world. A digital competence framework is now introducing digital skills across the curriculum, preparing them for the opportunities and risks that an online world presents.
- Meanwhile teachers will have more freedom to teach in ways they feel will have the best outcomes for their learners.
- The central focus of assessment arrangements is to ensure learners understand how they are performing and what they need to do next. There is a renewed emphasis on assessment for learning as an essential and integral feature of learning and teaching.
